### SESAR and Future ATM Development Projects

**Friday 12<sup>th</sup> December 2008**

This breakfast, forum and luncheon will serve as the finale to the ATM KN's efforts in 2008 by providing an opportunity for UK industry and academia to be updated on and focus upon the large development projects driving forward ATM today.

- Opportunities offered by the largest ever European ATM development project, the Single European Sky Air Traffic Management Research (**SESAR**) programme will be examined and explained by its **Chief Technical Architect, Mr Peter Hotham**. New insights into the programme will be provided following the formal launch of the SESAR "Joint Undertaking" on 8<sup>th</sup> December 2008.
- The US equivalent of SESAR, the "Next Generation Air Transportation System" (or simply '**NextGen**') will also be represented at the event **by Mr Donald Ward** who leads the NextGen/SESAR interoperability efforts for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).
- The UK's Ministry of Defence "**Joint Military Air Traffic Services**" (**JMATS**) project will be represented at the event by **Squadron Leader Al Corner** who will talk about the programme itself, its structure and how industry can get involved.
- The **National Air Traffic Services (NATS)** will take the opportunity to give their perspective on SESAR. Their views will be presented by **Mr Andrew Dobson, the Senior Programme Manager for the SESAR programme at NATS**.
- The **Head of European ATM Policy Co-Ordination at the Civil Aviation Administration (CAA), Mr Neil Perry**, will outline the CAA's activities within SESAR and provide a regulatory view on how it will impact UK aviation.

Hosted by SEEDA (South East England Development Agency) and supported by both The Aerospace and Defence Knowledge Transfer Network and the Farnborough Aerospace Consortium (FAC), the provisional agenda promises a landmark event.
