Research Grants

In order to promote long-term collaboration with universities, EUROCONTROL initiates a research grant scheme with a view to award grants for a duration of up to five (5) years, in exchange for two (2) annual deliverables amongst five (5) generic possibilities:

- 1) Publication of a scientific article in a recognised and reknown scientific publication,
- 2) Supervision and hosting of EEC-sponsored PhD researchers,
- 3) Delivery of specialised course related to ATM (to a public selected by EEC),
- 4) Co-organising of ATM scientific conference (such as ICRAT), or
- 5) Editing of scientific volume (such as guest editor for ATM quarterly).

Who should submit a proposal: All companies and entities performing innovative research work in the above domain and having the necessary experience.

Closing date: 15 November 2007

NOTE: After 1 November 2007 the call for proposal documentation will in principle no longer be despatched.
